SEC Registration and Incorporation as UP College of Pharmacy Alumni Association (UPCPAA), Inc.

The first step of the new board was to conduct a strategic planning for the years 2018-2020 at the Alabang Country Club on July 21, 2018. The board identified the need to convert the association into a legal entity to be crucial in realizing our main objectives of undertaking activities, projects and programs in support of the UP College of Pharmacy and of promoting the general welfare of the alumni. The revision of the current Constitution and By-laws of the association was discussed as an initial step in the registration at the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). A final draft was approved by the board on January 19, 2019 and sent to Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). Last March 29, 2019, the official Certificate of Incorporation as University of the Philippines College of Pharmacy Alumni Association (UPCPAA), Inc. was issued.

The process of getting the Barangay Clearance, Mayor's Permit, printing of the BIR official receipts followed soon after. Once all documents are obtained, a bank account at BDO PGH-Taft Avenue Branch will be opened under the name of UPCPAA, Inc.

This does not only mark the transition of the former UP Pharmacy Alumni Association to the UP College of Pharmacy Alumni Association, (UPCPAA) Inc. but also paves the way for a closer relationship among all of the alumni of the UP College of Pharmacy and generate greater support for the college.
